That the Constitution of the Glenorchy Historical Society Inc. be amended by the addition of the following clause:-

10A. Exemptions under the Act

- (1) For any financial year that the Association is exempt from the requirement to be audited by virtue of section 24(1B) or (1C) of the Act –
- (a) an auditor is not required to be appointed for that financial year under rule 9 unless the Association elects to have the financial affairs of the Association for that financial year audited in accordance with the Act and these rules; and
- (b) if an auditor is not appointed for a financial year by virtue of paragraph (a) -
- (i) rules 9 and 10 do not apply in respect of the Association for that financial year; and
- rules 11(5)(b), to the extent that it relates to an auditor, does not apply in respect of the annual general meeting held by the Association in respect of that financial year; and
- (iii) rule 11(5)(b) does not apply in respect of the annual general meeting held by the Association in respect of that financial year.
- For any financial year that the Association is exempt from the requirement to provide an annual return by virtue of 24B(1B) of the Act, the committee must provide, as part of the ordinary business of the annual general meeting for that financial year, a copy of the annual financial report given under the *Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission Act 2012* of the Commonwealth in respect of that financial year.
